

A newly-formed nonprofit corporation ...Jeremiah's Circle of Friends, Inc. (JCF), is in the late planning phase of starting a neighborhood legal services clinic in Southwest Washington, DC --- the only quadrant of the city that currently has no neighborhood legal services. The organization, with the support of Kirkland & Ellis LLP and Friendship Baptist Church, intends to open a full-service legal clinic two half-days per week beginning this summer, and to add a third half-day soon thereafter. The Church is providing the space for the clinic and its senior pastor, the Reverend J. Michael Little, who is also a graduate of Georgetown Law Center, will be its Executive Director. JCF is searching for a DC-licensed attorney with 5 or more years in practice to serve as the primary staff attorney for the clinic. The clinic will operate two half-days per week at the outset, with volunteer legal services and support provided pro bono by Kirkland initially and hopefully other law firms over time. The principal staff attorney will assist with the pre-opening planning phase of the project, as well as run the clinic during operating hours. Compensation --\$25/hour anticipated 15 to 20 hours/week. Applications need to be highly motivated and well-organized and should have demonstrated strong management and leadership skills, as well as a commitment to legal aid and public service work. Experience with legal services organizations and pro bono programs very desirable. Interested individuals should send their resumes to Reverend J.
