Wayne State University Law School is seeking candidates for a position as a clinical faculty member. Wayne Law currently has four live-client clinics (Child Advocacy, Criminal Appeals, Disability Law, and Small Business/Nonprofit Corporations). We are seeking individuals with clinical teaching experience to establish, direct, teach, and supervise a new in-house clinic. Our plan at present is to establish an Asylum and International Human Rights Law Clinic, although we are open to considering outstanding candidates in other fields that would diversify our clinical offerings and address the unmet legal needs of the surrounding urban community. The position is non-tenure-track, usually starting with a 3-year contract, with the possibility of renewal and long-term contracts. Minimum qualifications for the position include a J.D. degree, at least one year of clinical teaching experience, and admission to the State Bar of Michigan (or eligibility for admission without examination.
